God treats you as you see yourself!

Psalm 18:26-27 'With the pure You will show Yourself merciful; With a blameless man You will show Yourself blameless; With the pure You will show Yourself pure; And with the devious You will show Yourself shrewd.'

Matt. 15:21-28 'The Canaanite woman had a correct picture of who Jesus was and included herself and received an answer to her prayer.'

John 4:4 + 23 'But He needed to go through Samaria – But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth;...'

Mark 9:7 '... This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!'

You become what you believe you are. You can do what you believe you can do. You live as you think you are capable of living.

Are you able to see yourself as one who has exchanged places with Jesus? All His is now yours.

Who is now more righteous? Jesus or you??? The answer will define your identity.

2 Cor. 5:17 'Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old things have passed away; SEE, all things have become new.'

- **If you can see it, you can have it. It's all about what you can see. (Worship and revelation will flow)**
- **If you draw the right conclusions about yourself, then nothing is impossible for you.**
- **If you can see yourself as God sees you, then you will have a wonderful life ahead of you.**
- **If you can include yourself then suddenly you will be a part of God's plan and an answer to this world.**
- **The gospel's goal is to restore the true nature / identity of each person**

How did I receive it?

Rom. 5:17 'For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.'

The gift of righteousness is so perfect and complete, that I am just as accepted by God as Jesus is! Jesus obeyed in my place. My acceptance before God is based on what Jesus did for me.

2 Kings 2:1-5 'The cloak did the same for Elijah as it did for Elisha'

Acts 1:1-11 ‘...but to wait for the promise of the Father, “which, He said, you have heard from Me;.....but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit...’
The Holy Spirit will do the same for us as it did for Jesus.

John 16:5-11 ‘The Holy Spirit’s 3 fold work: conviction of sin, righteousness and judgement.’

If the Holy Spirit can convince you that you can receive the gift of righteousness by simple faith, and that you can walk in righteousness, then you will experience that you will always and in every situation have an open heaven over your life. You will begin to rule and reign over every situation in your life. In other words, you will have dominion and life.

Obedience to God’s Word will always take you further than your understanding ever will.
